

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

SECTION 10 19 10 - PRIVACY CURTAINS

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.01 SUMMARY

- A. This section includes the following:
 - 1. Privacy curtain and track.

1.02 SUBMITTALS

- A. Product Data: Manufacturer's printed product data for each type of privacy curtain and track specified.
- B. Fabric Samples: Swatch cards of fabric samples weave.

1.03 WARRANTY

A. Standard Limited Warranty against material and manufacturing defects.

1.04 MAINTENANCE MATERIALS

A. Extra Materials: Provide 1 extra curtain to be turned over to owner.

PART 2 - PRODUCTS

2.01 MANUFACTURER

- A. Basis of Design: InPro Corporation, PO Box 406 Muskego, WI 53150 USA; Telephone: 800-222-5556, Fax: 888-715-8407, Internet address: http://www.inprocorp.com.
- B. Substitutions: Equivalent products by other manufacturers will be allowed.

A.02 MATERIALS

- A. Privacy Curtain: Shield by Panaz Antimicrobial Fabric Privacy Curtain
 - 1. Provide non woven, 100% polyester fabric, modified with nano-molecular, anti-bacterial and water repellent technologies. Fabric shall be anti-bacterial and stain resistant.
 - 2. Open Mesh Cloth: Provide curtain heading of open weave nylon mesh material with #50 1/2" holes to permit air circulation. Mesh is to be flame retardant, washable and dry-cleanable.

B. Track:

- 1. CES Track Series CE5038 with ball and chain carriers.
- 2. Suspend from 8'-6" tall ceiling so track runs under existing lights.

C. Amount:

1. Provide a total of 3 curtains. Install 2 curtain and provide additional curtain to owner as maintenance stock.

2.03 FINISH AND COLOR

- A. Shield Designer Fabric.
 - 1. Select solid or patterned fabric from manufacturer's standard selection. Fabric shall have a satin luster and printed on both sides.
- B. EZE•Mesh Top
 - Select mesh material in a color from manufacturer's standard selection.

2.04 FABRICATION

- A. Privacy Curtain
 - 1. Curtain Width: Manufacture curtains of one piece, sized to 10 percent wider than the track length but no less than 1'-0" extra fullness;
 - 2. Curtain Height: 7'-0". Bottom of privacy curtain hangs 1/2" above floor;
 - 3. Curtain Heading: Manufacture with heading of open mesh cloth, to the same width as the curtain fabric. Include 4-ounce nickel-plated grommets, 6" on center for carriers. Top hem to be triple-turned hem over nylon tape for rugged wear.
 - 4. Seams: Curtains shall be seamless with sanitary "no scum" side and bottom edges. Sewing thread to be triple-ply twisted nylon.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.01 EXAMINATION

- A. Examine areas and conditions in which the curtain tracking systems will be installed.
 - 1. Complete all finishing operations, including painting, before beginning installation of cubicle tracking system materials.
 - 2. Verify that surfaces and above ceiling supports/blocking are ready to receive work.

3.02 PREPARATION

A. General: Prior to installation, clean substrate to remove dust, debris and loose particles.

3.03 INSTALLATION

A. Install the curtain track in accordance with the manufacturer's instuctions.

3.04 CLEANING

A. At completion of the installation, remove any debris and clean surfaces in accordance with the track clean-up and maintenance instructions.
