<p><a href="#"><u>Controlling Billbug Grubs in Lawns</u></a></p>	<p>Describes symptoms and control strategies for billbug grubs (<i>larvae</i>) in Idaho lawns. Nonchemical strategies include growing grass varieties that are resistant to billbug feeding and applying certain nematodes or a fungus that attacks and kills the grubs. Chemical controls include contact and systemic insecticides.</p>
<p><a href="#"><u>Managing Boxelder Bugs Around Your Home</u></a></p>	<p>A common nuisance pest in Idaho, boxelder bugs can become intolerably numerous. Learn their appearance, hosts, and life cycle and ways you can manage them with and without insecticides.</p>
