- Breeding animals checked in at weigh in
 - Classes determined after weighing
 - Grand Reserve will have a spot to stay
- Place for kids will be available from fair board to get dressed
- Show will go as follows market, DecWeg, Showmanship, Breeding.
 - What about show for spares.
- Nothing set up on East end of Salebarn (Picture Area)
- No animals south of white rail by dairy barn
- No Canopies until Tuesday, cleaned up by 8:00am Saturday
- Keep your area clean.
- Can utilize beef, sheep, and back area to prep animals. That has to be cleaned by 4:30pm. on Tuesday.

Pre Fair Meeting

1. Avian Influenza
 - a. All Turkeys will be tested the week prior to fair
 - i. If a turkey tests negative but becomes sick these animals will not be allowed at fair
 - ii. Turkeys will be housed on the north section of the sale barn where the goats are
 - iii. Turkey youth use the far north wash racks day of show
 - iv. Upon weighing in Tuesday take your birds up the road to your area from the beef scales
 - v. When you go to the outdoor show ring for your show use the west gate to enter and exit
 - b. General Biosecurity
 - i. No communal troughs
 - ii. Keep all walkways clear of manure
 - iii. Feed will be stored in your trailers/not in the animal area
 - iv. Keep pens clean
 - v. Walkway on the east side of the pig barn
 - vi. All equipment and hoses keep cleaned up
 - vii. Breeding projects
 1. Consider Quarantine procedures when you go home for 10-14 days
2. No room at the Inn
 - a. Lots of animals, tight spaces fitting equipment needs to be in designated areas
 - i. All areas for housing animals will have animals, No chair /camping areas
 - b. No sheep goat covers put up until Tuesday after weigh in
 - i. Canopies have to be all moved Saturday morning at 8 AM from Southside of Sale barn
 - ii. East side of sale barn will have an area set up for pictures
3. 3 Strike rule- We will be monitoring this year
 - a. Any of the things we have talked about as well as any of the things in the rule book fall under this category.
 - b. 3 strikes and will not be allowed to participate next year
