 2. Record books & judging:
 - a. Horse record books are due July 29th by 4 p.m. (2 points deducted for every ten minutes late, no books accepted after 5 p.m.)
 - b. All livestock record books (including dog) are due July 31st by 4 p.m. (2 points deducted for every ten minutes late, no books accepted after 5 p.m.)
 3. Schedule: The following species will come in on the dates below to judge record books. Species will not be judging their own species. The office has sorted each species out by numbers. All judging will begin at 6:30 p.m. Dinner will be provided. We need at least 12 (except for dog & horse, we only need 6) adults from each species. Preferably no more than 2 from each club.
