

October 4-H Day Camp Classes

Cinnamon Rolls and Simple Chili

In this class, you will learn how to make cinnamon rolls. You will make the dough, learn about yeast and raising, roll out the dough, form cinnamon rolls, learn oven safety, make frosting, and frost cinnamon rolls. You will also make a simple chili recipe where you will brown hamburger, measure spices, use a can opener, and safety while stirring on the stove top. You will get to eat some and (if you don't eat all of it 😊) take some home.

Superhero Capes and Masks

This is a simple sewing class. You will need to bring your choice of fabric one yard each of two contrasting fabrics, thread to match, and one sheet of felt in your choice of color. We will learn how to pin a pattern, cut out the pattern, match and pin edges of fabric, sew fabric together, determine right side and wrong side of fabric, and sew a straight stitch and seam finishes.

Monster Key Chain

This class involves engineering, design and construction. You will create a monster of your choice using pieces of wood, screws, nails, and hooks. You will be able to create multiple monsters.

Spooky Ghost

This class will be using hot glue to assemble a cute countertop ghost. The ghost base is a paper towel dispenser. This cute craft will be a fun decoration for years to come.

Cloverbuds

Cloverbuds is a class designed for 5–8-year-olds. It is a hands-on class where we have a different theme each month. Cloverbuds typically meet 3 times per month, depending on the month the day may be different than Thursday. This month we are learning about cooking. We will make biscuits, butter, stone soup, and a surprise treat. Parent helpers are welcome.

Polymer Clay Coasters

You will be learning how to take different colors and shapes of clay to create canes. These canes will then be used to create small tiles or motifs that will be built into a sheet of repeating patterns. You will then take the sheet and other small tiles and create coasters. Coasters will be baked, sanded, and glazed to produce a finished coaster.

Hairpin Lace

You will learn how to use the hairpin lace tool, crochet hook, stitch and yarn to create a section of hairpin loops. Then you will learn how to join multiple sections to create a bookmark or scarf.

Ghost Door Hanging

For this craft, you will use hot glue or tacky glue, rope and cardboard to create a fun door or wall hanging.
