

4-H Sewing Machines

Since 2005 there have been eight sewing machines available for use in Southern Idaho. The machines are currently housed by and reserved through the Minidoka County Extension Office. This equipment is designed to promote Idaho 4-H Sewing Projects and encourage sewing service projects.

A \$5 per day per machine fee will be charged to the County Extension Office or Idaho 4-H volunteer that uses the machines in an educational or promotional situation. This fee will be assessed for days that the machines are in operation. Transport and storage days will not be charged. The equipment includes: 8 complete sewing machines in rolling totes that include scissors, hem gauges, seam rippers, measuring tapes, straight pins and magnetic pin cushions. The person who checks out the machines is responsible for picking them up and is responsible for returning them unless other arrangements are approved. This person is also responsible for any damages incurred while in their possession and will be charged for the repair. Normal wear and tear will be taken care of from the use fees.
