- Faculty Senate is discussing a proposal by Vice Chair Murphy to include a stronger resolution process in the way senate business is conducted.
- Dean of Students Blaine Eckles and Crystal Hogg, Director of Student Affairs Operations, provided updates on the status of the Children's Center. The most pressing need is space for extension. The high cost of childcare was also discussed.
- Brian Smentkowski, Director of the Center for Excellence in Teaching and Learning (CETL), presented a number of initiatives from CETL aimed at supporting faculty success through innovation, fostering collaborations, and improved morale.
